
Fall 2015 Foray: Montgomery County

Saturday October 3, 9:30 am: Our first stop will be Possum Creek Metropark, 4790 Frytown Road, Dayton, Ohio 45417, which is southwest of downtown Dayton:




If you're traveling on US Route 35, you can take the Gettysburg Ave. exit south to Frytown Road, turn west to the park entrance on Frytown Road. You can also take Ohio Route 4 to Frytown Road and go east to the entrance.


GPS Coordinates for the park are: Latitude: 39.71682 Longitude: -84.265808

Note: if you'll be traveling through downtown Dayton (particularly I-75), a last-minute check of road construction in that area is probably a good idea.


We'll meet at the Argonne Forest Parking area in Possum Creek Metropark:




After lunch at Possum Creek, we'll travel south on State Route 4 (Germantown Pike) to Manning Road, turn right (west) on Manning to Conservancy Road, then left (south) on Conservancy.




We'll drive into the park at the 7101 Conservancy Road entrance and meet at the White-Tail parking area:


